Point wise highlights of the Event:

- The event began with the ceremonial lamp lighting ceremony and Saraswathi Vandana. Thereafter, the background to the topic of panel discussion was given by **Dr. Meenal Sharma Jagtap**. The Opening remarks were delivered by **Prof.(Dr.) Padmakali Banerjee, Dean Academics & Head, Centre for BRICS Studies**. She spoke about the critical skills that would be required in the future and how industry and academia need to adopt an integrated approach to meet the challenge thrown open by the emergence of new technologies.
- The first speaker among the invited guests was Ms. **Poonam Barua**, who spoke on the challenges that the leadership in the ‘new age’ organizations are going to face while tackling with technology in all aspects and the change of role titles in organizations.
- Next in line of illustrious speakers was **Mr. Arihant Garg** who occupies a senior leadership position in KPMG. He opined that new technology/processes such as Artificial Intelligence, Big Data, and Machine Learning would be the levers for businesses of tomorrow. He also said that ‘Analytics’ is changing business. It helps business work out Intelligent Information with the big data being generated today. This intelligent information can be used for intelligent predictions as well as forecasting.
- The next speaker for the afternoon was **Mr. Saurabh Agarwal**, who spoke on cyber security and privacy. He focused his address on the students and told them that in future the jobs will not become extinct as is being feared. However, the way we do work would definitely change drastically. He said that the ability to think- AI is catching up, while human intelligence lagging behind. Hence, it is imperative that we use the technology platform to bring in better results and bring in a lot of thought process.

- The last speaker for the afternoon was **Mr. Anilesh Mahajan**, who has been in media for last 20 years. He spoke on the role of government and about the need to think about the impact of technology and Industrial Revolution 4.0 on employment in developing countries.
- Senior faculty members from AUH including **Prof.(Dr) Vikas Madhukar**, Director Admissions& Marketing, Dy. Director, ABS and Prof. (Dr.) U N Singh who is the Dean of Faculty of Arts were also present who asked pertinent questions from the panelists, thus, sparking a lively discussion. This session was interactive one and many faculty members present interacted with the speakers.
- Finally, the event concluded with the vote of thanks that was delivered by Ms. Reena Nigam, Head of the Institute, Amity Skills Institute, AUH.
