Students reached the Earth savior foundation by college bus provided by the university at 10:30 am. The visit started with the welcome and brief introduction about the savior foundation by the founder, Mr. Ravi Kalra ji. The Earth Saviours Foundation is an internationally recognized NGO, situated in Gurgaon, Haryana, India. It was founded in 2008 by Ravi Kalra. He is a well-known Karma Yogi, social activist and environmentalist. The Foundation is dedicated to serve less privileged people and is making every possible effort to protect the environment. The Earth Saviours Foundation is registered under 80 G of Income Tax Exemption Act and FCRA license from The Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India. The selfless, dedicated, committed, vigilant staff and volunteers of The Earth Saviours Foundation are working day and night for the community welfare.

Some of the ongoing missions are:

- Old age home to look after homeless - abandoned senior citizens.
- Rescue center to look after mentally disabled people.
- “Do Not Honk” campaign to reduce noise pollution by educating drivers not to honk unnecessarily while driving.

- Jia Nari Niketan shelter to look after deprived females.
- Battle to save environment and its habitats.

After the introduction he told students to interact with the residents as it is their activity and leisure time. During the interaction staffs from the foundation provided Snacks to our students. Our students started the interaction with residents of the foundation. Performed Role play on Personal hygiene, Environmental sanitation and various communicable and non-communicable diseases and its prevention.

Later, our students gave 104 pieces of hygiene kit to the residents of the foundation which consists of Tooth brush, Tooth Paste, Hand kerchief and soap. Also distributed biscuits, soft drinks and banana to them. Lunch was provided by the foundation to all our students and faculty. Then we bid goodbye to them and left that place by 2 pm and reached Amity campus by 4pm.
