Workshop on ‘Clinical Assessment and Therapy’

Amity Institute of Behavioural and Allied Sciences organized a one day workshop on ‘Clinical assessment and Therapy’ for its UG and PG students on 12th May 2016 during the post lunch session. The session was conducted by Dr. Monalisa Palith, Clinical psychologist, Vimhans, Delhi (India). Workshop was inaugurated and addressed by Prof. (Dr.) Padmakali Banerjee, Pro Vice-Chancellor and Dean Academics. Prof. Archana Shukla, Director, AIBAS and Prof. (Dr.) Rishipal, HoD, AIBAS welcomed Dr. Monalisa and addressed the students. Dr. Monalisa interacted with the students and talked to them about the scope of the field of Clinical psychology. She elaborated upon the various types of assessments used in the field of psychology especially cognitive functioning assessments and achievement tests. Various tests like Weschler Intelligence scales, 16 personality factor, Minnesota multiphasic personality inventory were discussed in detail during the session. She also emphasized on DSM-V as a standardized diagnostic manual. Approximately 80 students from UG and PG along with the faculty members attended the session.
