Existing buildings can often be energy efficient through their use of good ventilation, durable materials, and spatial relationships. An immediate advantage of use of older buildings is the saving of time, new building materials, infrastructure etc. Minor modifications can be made to adopt existing buildings to compatible new uses. Services in the existing buildings can be upgraded to meet modern building requirements. This not only makes good economic sense, but preserves our legacy and is an inherently sustainable practice.
