The Heritage Transport Museum is situated on a three-acre plot, off National Highway 8 at Tauru-Gurgaon. A built-up area of over 90,000 square feet of air-conditioned space spread over four floors houses the exhibition galleries, library and reference centre, conference rooms, mini auditorium, the museum shop, and a restaurant facility. The museum showcases the evolution of transportation in India and sets a benchmark in interpretation, exhibition and in communication. As the first private museum of its scale in India, it is conceived as a didactive space that engages visitor participation in learning while remaining a family experience.

Heritage Transportation Trust is responsible for overall management of the Transportation museum which has a collection of rare & vintage automobiles, buses, aircraft & trains. Setting up of the Museum has been undertaken with Financial Assistance from the Ministry of Culture, Government of India.

23 students of Bachelor of Travel & Tourism Management Programme had visited the museum where they had a chance to explore various forms of transport system. They experienced a multi-experiential facility that explores the history of transportation, with an emphasis on the Indian context. The mechanized audio players were provided to the students for the tour of the museum and the tour was followed by a documentary for 40 min.
