name and identity was felt. As a result, the existing body of Chef's forum was renamed as 'Indian Culinary Forum' (ICF).

In 1987 election was held and Chef Manjit Gill was elected as the President of the newly formed Indian

Federation of Culinary Associations. Presently Chef Davinder Kumar is holding the position of President, ICF. Renowned Indian Chefs of International repute, joined the ICF as Members of the Governing Body.



ICF creates opportunities for young Chefs by arranging Trade Tests through reputed Hotel Management Institutes. Workshops and Seminars on Culinary Industry related topics are organized by ICF very frequently.

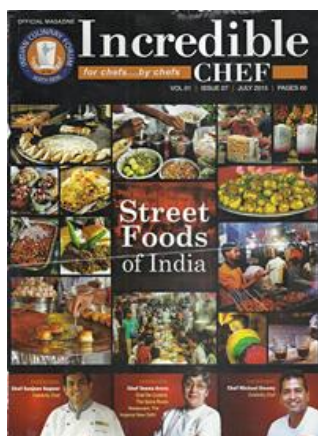
