

Workshop on Drawing and Illustration

This workshop was organized by ASFA and ASI on 15.02.2019. The workshop was conducted by Mr. Mohit Kant Mishra, a professional Illustrator. The workshop was attended by approximately 30 students from ASFA, AID & ASFDT (approx. 30)

In this workshop students were taught how to create detailed drawings and illustrations using software. They were made to watch detailed illustration tutorials and training from creative professionals sharing their tips, techniques and workflows used to create stunning imagery. An illustration is a decoration, interpretation or visual explanation of a text, concept or process, designed for integration in published media, such as posters, flyers, magazines, books, teaching materials, animations, video games and films. Going forward doing the same using advanced software is the way to go in the industry of design and architecture. While the topics of designing are included in the curriculum, the knowledge and skills required to apply software to the same are not taught in mainstream lectures. Hence, the training was organised by ASFA to bridge the gap between knowledge and employment.

The industry is majorly being run on computer software and by providing the knowledge and skills to the students in this area is of profound importance to make them more employable and relevant for the industry.
